AROUND THE WORLD

BROADWAY

There is nothing currently running on Broadway at present, but in an effort to begin to get things back to normal, members of the New York Philharmonic gave an outdoor concert at Lincoln Center for health care workers on Wednesday, 13 months after the novel coronavirus pandemic decimated their season.

Meryl Streep, Mary-Louise Parker, Audra McDonald, Kevin Klein, Carla Gugino and Keanu Reeves have signed on to perform in a new virtual play series this spring while Broadway is closed. The series kicks off Thursday with **THE THANKSGIVING PLAY** by Larissa FastHorse, directed by Leigh Silverman, starring Reeves, Bobby Cannavale Heidi Schreck and Alia Shawkat.

Early openings in 2022 include **CHICAGO** (Ambassador Theatre), **AIN'T TOO PROUD – The Life and Times of the Temptations** (Imperial Theatre) and **DIANA: The Musical** at the Longacre Theatre. Other shows planned for next year include **WICKED, THE BOOK OF MORMON, COME FROM AWAY, DEAR EVAN HANSON, GIRL FROM THE NORTH COUNTRY, HADESTOWN, HARRY POTTER AND THE CURSED CHILD, JAGGED LITTLE PILL, MEAN GIRLS, MJ** (a biological portrait of Michael Jackson), **MOULIN ROUGE The Musical, MRS DOUBTFIRE, THE MUSIC MAN, THE PHANTOM OF THE OPERA,** and **SIX.**

THE WEST END, LONDON

London's theatre situation is slightly more optimistic, with the following shows opening from 21 January 2022: **THE OCEAN AT THE END OF THE LANE, CINDERELLA, The Musical, BACK TO THE FUTURE: The Musical, BRING IT ON, LIFE OF PI, MAMMA MIA, & JULIET, THE PLAY THAT GOES WRONG, MAGIC GOES WRONG, THE DRIFTERS GIRL** (The Story of the Drifters), **THE LION KING, ONLY FOOLS AND HORSES – The Musical** and **THE PRINCE OF EGYPT.**

AUSTRALIA

Australia is doing better than hoped, with the following shows currently running: **HARRY POTTER AND THE CURSED CHILD** has returned to Melbourne, and **COME FROM AWAY** is playing in Brisbane until 9 May, **MOULIN ROUGE: The Musical** will begin from 21 August 2021 in Melbourne.

FRIENDS: The Musical Parody is doing a national tour this year, and Opera Australia stages **AIDA** in May. **HAMILTON** continues at Sydney's Lyric Theatre and later this year we will see **JAGGED LITTLE PILL. FROZEN** continues in Sydney as does **MAGIC MIKE LIVE** before an Australian tour.

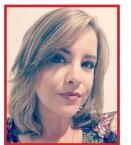
